Code of Behaviour Category A

- Attendance of all lessons is compulsory.
- Participation in all excursions and in all activities is compulsory.
- Mobile phones must be switched on silent during class time.
- Fire escapes and fire equipment are for emergency use only. They must not be used at any other time.
- BLS English does not accept any responsibility for personal items or money not handed in to staff for safekeeping.
- Food and drink may not be consumed during lessons.
- Students must respect all school property and put rubbish in the bins provided.
- Students must help to create a positive school atmosphere.
- Students must walk when moving about in school and take care on stair ways in particular.
- Students must not block corridors.

Sanctions for the above category would typically be as follows:

1. Conversation with Teacher. Warning.
2. Conversation with Academic Manager & Final Warning.
3. Expulsion from course and sent home.



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Code of Behaviour Category B

- Students must listen to and respect all staff and hosts. Communication is crucial.
- Students must respect others at all times. Bullying (i.e. aggressive or threatening behaviour towards other students) will not be tolerated.
- Racism will not be tolerated in any form.
- Students must not damage or graffiti school property.
- Alcohol or other prohibited substances are not permitted.
- Smoking AND vaping is not permitted in any of the buildings.
- Students must be home by the given time:
9pm for under 16; 10pm for 16-17 year olds; Or when your host tells you.
- Students must be careful not to endanger themselves or others on BLS English premises.

Sanctions for the above category would typically be as follows:

1. Conversation with Academic Manager & Final Warning.
2. Expulsion from course and sent home.

Depending on the severity of the misconduct, BLS English reserves the right to send any student home at the parents' expense with immediate effect. BLS also reserves the right to remove students from activities or excursions as a precautionary measure.
